MISSOURI AMENDMENT 3 (on the Nov 3 ballot) seeks to amend certain provisions in Article III of the Missouri Constitution which passed in 2018 with 62% of the vote.

A "NO" VOTE opposes amending the Missouri Constitution and supports maintaining:

- the state's use of a nonpartisan state demographer for legislative redistricting,
- the existing criteria used to draw legislative districts, and
- the existing campaign finance and lobbying limits.

**A "YES" VOTE** supports amending the Missouri Constitution to enact the following changes:

- eliminate the nonpartisan state demographer and instead use a bipartisan commission appointed by the governor for legislative redistricting,
- alter the criteria used to draw district maps,
- change the threshold of lobbyists' gifts from \$5 to \$0, and
- lower the campaign contribution limit for state senate campaigns from \$2,500 to \$2,400.
