His words reflect his Trinitarian view:

If we go to the ultimate source of that love which is the very life of the triune God, we encounter in the community of the three divine Persons the origin and perfect model of all life in society."

In our assembly last week, we talked about ways to grow spiritually. Let us consider studying this document, *Fratelli Tutti – On Fraternity and Social Friendship*, together as a guide for connecting with all and growing our faith community.
