



The cornerstone of the **second church** was laid on May 8th, 1856 and the church was dedicated November 28th, 1858.

The cornerstone of the **current church** was laid by Archbishop J.J. Kain on May 15th, 1898. The new church was dedicated on October 22nd, 1899, the fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the congregation.

The cornerstone reads: "May 15, 1898. This magnificent edifice erected to the honor and glory of God by the people of German tongue."
