PARISH ASSEMBLY AFTER MASS THIS MORNING:

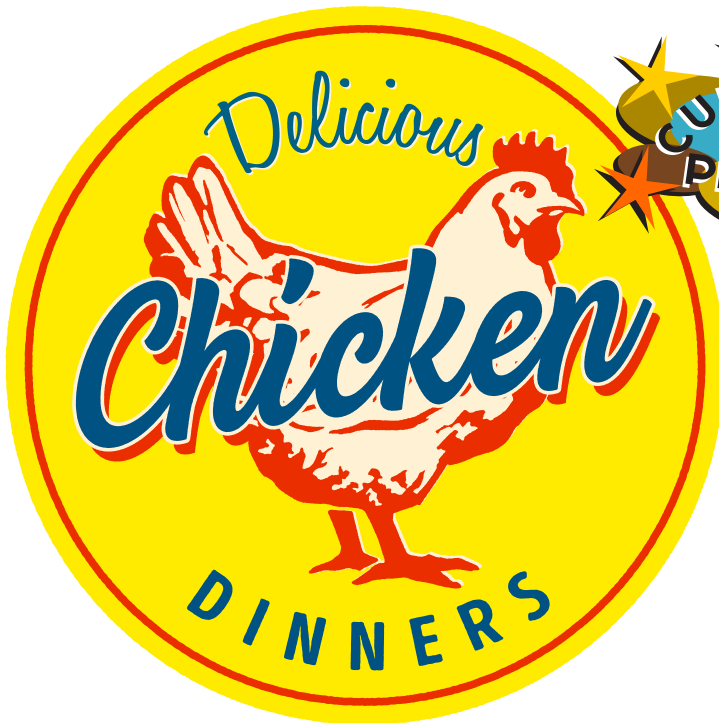
