Ordinary Time

The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time comprise the thirty or so weeks that are marked by extraordinary everyday moments of grace. Ordinary Time begins at Pentecost and continues to the First Sunday of Advent. The seasons of the Church reflect the rhythms of our lives, with peak moments and times of quiet growth. The liturgical color of Ordinary Time, green, reminds us that this is a season of growth in our discipleship, a time to continue maturing into the followers of Christ that we are meant to be.
