NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS WEEKEND,

JUNE 2 -4: Congress has a bill before them that will affect a ban on assault-style weapons. Also, the passage of Ethan's law, a bill in memory of Ethan Song, a teenager who accidentally shot himself with an unsecured gun, is again being considered. The bill prohibits improper storage of firearms on residential premises. Let us light a candle, united with all weekend candlelight vigils, praying in remembrance of those who lost life through gun violence.

Loving God, our hearts are broken with pain at the senseless deaths caused by gun violence. Families mourn, children live in fear. We ask that you touch our hearts with your love, heal our brokenness, and turn us away from violence toward peace.

 - *Let our voices be raised asking our legislators to enact gun laws to protect all in our society, especially those most vulnerable.*
