Religion is very realistic and the gospel is clear.
Jesus is at the side of the people in a “deserted place.” When the disciples suggest dismissing the crowd to go to

the village for food, Jesus refuses to follow their suggestion.
In all of Jesus’ words and actions he mentors his disciples (and us) in what it means to follow him. Instead of sending crowds away, invite the people closer. Instead of telling them to go and take care of their own needs, disciples of Jesus are the

ones called to feed the people themselves.
In today’s gospel we are called to be and live as disciples of Jesus. In other words, we solve our own personal needs when we share time with our neighbor.

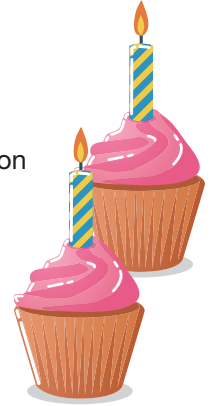
