## A WEEK OF SAINTS

**Monday, September 27:** St. Vincent de Paul devoted his life to acts of charity, organizing groups to provide food and clothing to the poor. Food pantries throughout the world, including ours, are honored with his name. We celebrate our St. Vincent de Paul volunteers: Mike Freymuth, Doris Speed and Joe Tracy who give their time and service at the food Pantry weekly.

**Wednesday, September 29:** Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. These three archangels traditionally hold special roles as servants of God who minister to all.

*Michael* is a warrior against evil who manifests that the authority of God is the power of Love.
